Assignment #6: "Class Display Class Show" Exhibition of your work in progress for "On Friday Project". READ ALL BELOW INFORMATION CAREFULLY BEFORE DOING ASSIGNMENT!

Due: 2 matted or mounted on foam core prints are due: Thursday, January 13, 2011, Crit #5.

Challenge:

- You are to make the best aesthetically and technically pleasing digital photographs to be displayed from Monday, January 17, 2011 Friday, February 4, 2011. In the Center Cases, 2nd floor Gannett Building. Do not take the work down early from the display cases.
- An artist statement with your letter head is to accompany the work submitted.
- To illustrate some of the work you have generated in this long term project for class.

Objective:

• Using the color theories & techniques we have discussed in class, create 2 photograph's printed as digital ink jet prints to illustrate your take on "On Friday".

Materials:

- Your two best prints to display your style or unique techniques from this quarter's "On Friday Project".
- Please print at the best color balanced ink jet prints that you can.
- I require that you matt or mount the prints for the exhibition.
- They will hold up better in the cases for two weeks.
- Also, an Artist Statement elaborating on your project proposal with your letter head and contact information

Procedure:

- Photograph interesting compositions and content at all times.
- Illustrate what you have learned from all the classes and assignments to date.
- Think about topics of interest that excite you and you will be able to work with.

Submit:

- In your small portfolio envelope, include the following. (NO PLASTIC BAGS!)
- On your original stationary that has all your contact information, an assessment for the assignment.
- On your original stationary that has all your contact information, a brief 200 word artist statement discussing the reason/content of your photographs to be placed in the cases with your work.
- 2 digital photographs of your choice output on 8.5 x 11 inch paper.
- Clean window mats or foam core around 11 x 14 inches in size.
- Make sure your name is on the back of the original print, and on the back of the matt.
- All ink jet digital file at 300ppi resolution.
- Make sure everything is clearly identified that you hand in.
- The best way to put your name on matte ink jet prints is to write with a #2 pencil on the back.
- The best way to put your name on glossy ink jet prints is to write with a Sharpie.
