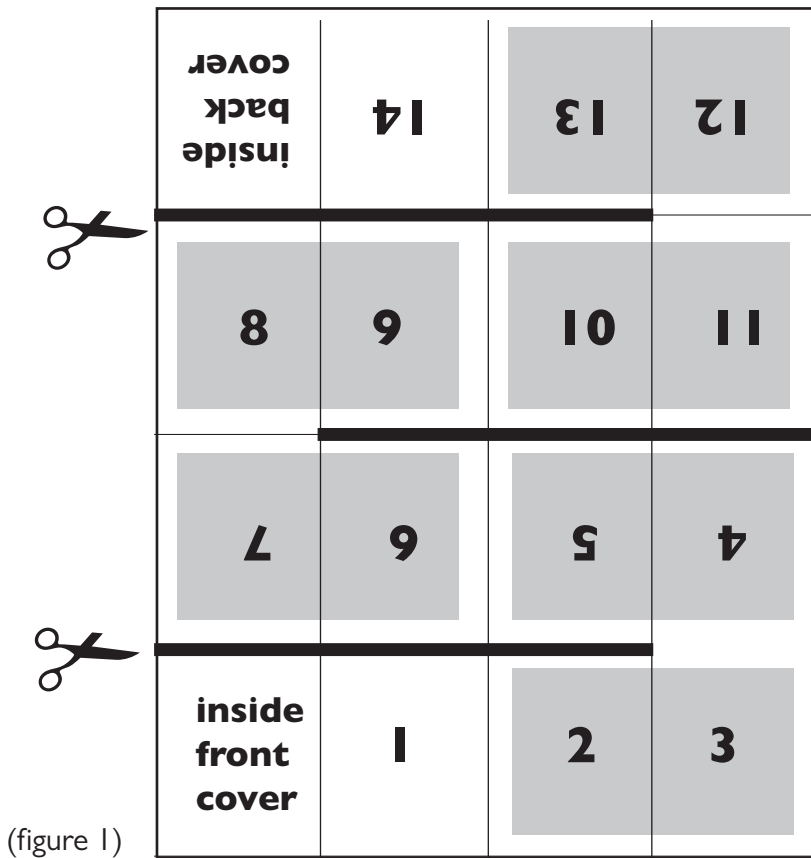


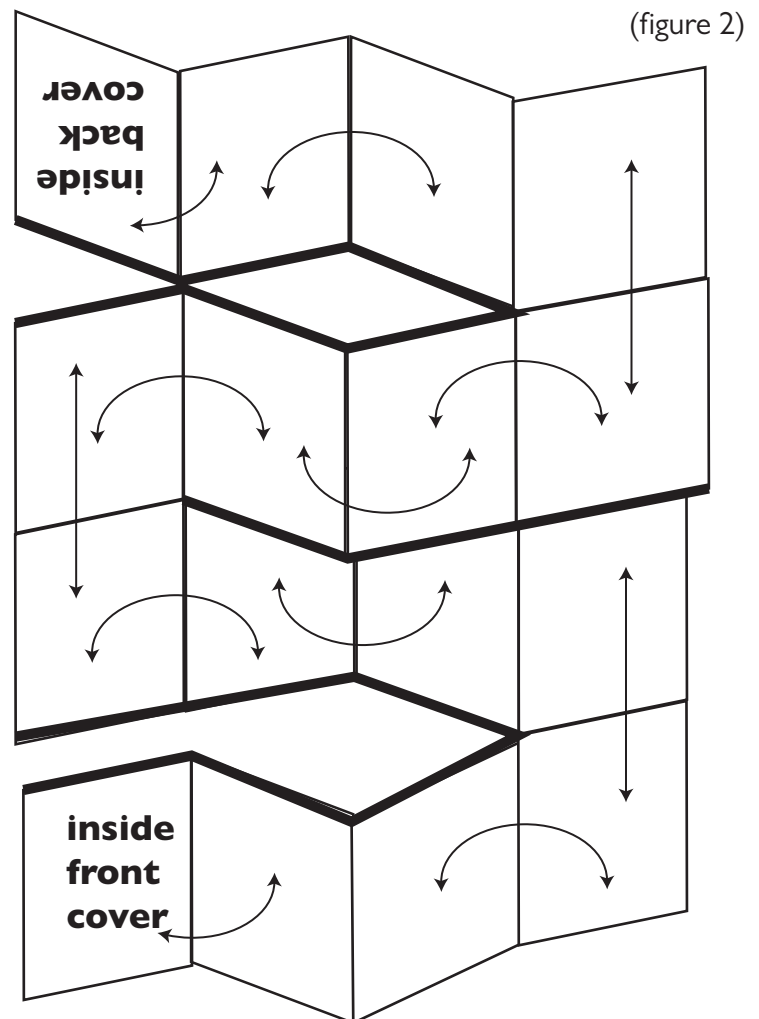
Cutting and Accordion Fold

Placement of pages, spreads, and cutting.

First and third rows are right-side up.
 Second and fourth rows are upside down.
 Spreads are shown in gray.
 Cut along heavy lines.

The book is constructed by a type of accordion fold. Begin folding the book by folding the inside front cover face to face with page 1, page 1 back to back with page 2; page 2 face to face with 3. Flip page 3 up back to back with 4; page 4 face to face with 5, and so on. The blank first and last pages become the “endsheets” and slide into the pocket of the cover to finish the book.
