ORIGIN a shortening of weblog.

Procedure and Requirements:

- Seach the web for FREE Blog Sites.

- Set up the Blog so your class peers can view the work you post.
- If you currently have a blog, you can continue to use this for the assignment.
- Share your Blog URL with your classmates.
- Update your blog at least 2 days a week with posting's of images and text.

Technique:

- Images will have to be keyword and include your name and copyright in the meta date.
- Images will have to be 72ppi resolution. Generally 800ppi wide x 600 ppi high.
- Layout can vary over time until you feel comfortable with the look of your blog.
- Update your blog at least 2 days a week with posting's of images and text.
- Make a .pdf file of each new entry and save it to your external hard drive.
- The blog will be an extension of your comments, critiques and exploration of photography.

Submit:

- An assessment for the project on your original stationary that has all your contact information.
