Objective:

• Using the reference resources at the LeRoy V. Good Library Building an email 4, .jpg images. 800ppiW x 600ppiH x 72ppi resolution .jpg images on medium to high compression.

Procedure:

Using the information at your disposal at MCC, write an essay dealing this one of the two broad topics, "Contemporary Photography" or "Digital Photography."

- 1. Look up a photographer or topic of your choice that pertains to the topics of contemporary photography or digital photography.
- 2. Try and find at least 4, .jpg image to illustrate your essay.
- 3. Give a brief description of historical fact about the topic, process, equipment or photographer you focus on.
- 4. To do this research paper, you must pull reference from at least two of the following resources.
 - A. Library book shelves.
 - B. Magazines or periodicals.
 - C. The Internet.
 - D. Published books in own collection.
- 5. Use APA style to write Bibliography to list your resources.
- 6. After you have gathered your research using your computer & the library's resources, I want you to do the following.
 - A. Write the essay on correct grammar and spelling.
 - B. Locate 4 images to illustrate the essay.
 - C. Open up a new email to my account, joez@joe-ziolkowski.com
 - D. Paste the text of the essay into the email.
 - E. Attach your 4, .jpg images. Make sure your name is in the title of the files to email.
 - F. Have your name in the subject matter of the email.
 - G. Send the text enclosed email with attached .jpgs to me by Monday, October 6, 2008.
 - H. If you want to send an attached .pdf with your full letterhead with contact information, that would be a plus.

Document Requirements:

Your document (excluding the title page and bibliography) should be at least 500 - 750 words. Please use a word processing program with a spelling and grammar check, AND please don't forget to proof-read your finished document! Think quality, not quantity after the minimum is met.

- Concerning the .jpg images for the presentation,

For a horizontal image, no larger than 800 pixels wide x 600 pixels high X 72 ppi resolution.

For a vertical image, no larger than 600 pixels high x 600 pixels wide x 72 ppi resolution.

Medium to high compression.

Can be RGB or gray scale.

- Your name and contact information must be at the beginning or the end of the presentation.
- The title of your artist or topic must be at the beginning of the presentation.
- Your references must be at the end of the presentation.
- Keep limited text consistent font and colors.
- Keep images separate from text.
- You can also send an attached .pdf of the final presentation.
- After the bibliography, you must paste in your assessment of the assignment.
- Send an attached assessment .pdf document with the project.
